Kingstown, RI has canceled their contract with Flock Safety , although the company's hardware may still appear along state routes under a contract with RI state police.

Ord city council voted 5-0 to remove their Flock cameras in response to residents' privacy concerns.			
Narragansett, RI	August 2026	✓ Contract Canceled	Collapse ^
A unanimous vote led to the cancellation of Narragansett's contract with Flock Safety, more than a year before it was set to expire.			
Madison, WI	July 2026	✓ Cameras Deactivated	Collapse ^
The University of Wisconsin-Madison Police Department will remove automated license plate reader cameras from campus after ending its contract with Flock Safety.			
Floyd County, VA	July 2026	✓ Cameras Deactivated	Collapse ^
Sheriff Brian Craig stated that the Flock cameras will be removed once the contract expires at the end of August. the cameras will be removed.

City council unanimously **voted down** a proposed contract with Flock Safety, rejecting the activation of Flock Cameras in the city, and also voted to cancel their existing contract.

Dutchtown, MO

The Dutchtown Community Improvement District **ended its contract** with Flock Safety amid concerns over data-sharing with ICE.

Knoxville, TN

Collapse ^

Flock cameras were **deactivated in Knoxville, TN** following a contract lapse. However, the city intends to pursue a contract with another vendor.

Mountain View, CA

February 2026

Collapse ^

The Mountain View Police Chief decided to **disable their Flock cameras** after noticing their cameras had been accessed by out-of-state and federal agencies, a violation of California law.

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
